Free Dump Weekends!

Waste Management will have *free* dump weekends at the Lockwood Landfill on April 15th, 16th, 17th, 29th, 30th and May 1st. The Landfill is located at 2401 Canyon Way, Sparks.

Hours of operation are:

Mon-Fri: 8:00am to 4:30pm Saturday: 8:00am to 3:30pm (for free dump weekends, only)

Sunday: CLOSED


Note: No commercial dumping will be accepted on the free dump weekends.

Payment Options for Assessments

- Coupon and Check, homeowners send their payment with their coupon direct to the bank at Woodland Village P.O. Box 68020 Phoenix, AZ 85082-8020.
- Online Bill Payment—www.CABanc.com
- Automated Clearing House, otherwise known as ACH. The Association receives authorization from the homeowner, including their routing and account number. An electronic file is created for the homeowner which is then sent to CABanc for processing.
- One-Time Payment through CABanc.com.
 Homeowners can go to www.cabanc.com and make a one-time payment to their association.
- Also, homeowners may drop off payments at the Association Office.

Maintenance

- Now is the time to check your irrigation system to make sure it is operational before warm weather arrives.
- Please water your Association tree at least 10-15 gallons per week, to help keep it healthy.
- Watering early in the morning between 3 a.m. and 9 a.m. is ideal because wind and temperatures are lower, minimizing evaporation. Never water during the heat of the day or when conditions are windy.
- Where to apply water is as important as when to apply it. As a plant grows, its root zone also grows and extends out and down. The roots that absorb water—the feeder roots—are concentrated at the outside edges of the plant's drip line (where rainwater drips off leaves to the ground). This is the area that should receive water. Position drip emitters here.



Compliance

- As a reminder, Homeowners are allowed 4 free pre-stained fence boards a year. Boards are available at the Association office.
- Please remember trash should be stored in appropriate covered containers, which will be stored within fenced rear yards or garages except 24 hours before and after collection.

Fence Stain

This year's fence stain schedule includes lots 188-383. 727-831 and 1302-1393. Stain can be picked up at the Association Office from 9:00am to 5:00pm Monday thru Friday.

Stain may also be picked up on the following Saturdays: April 24th and May 8 from

10:00am to 2:00pm at the Association shed.

Please remember you are required to stain both the inside and outside of your fence to keep it from deteriorating***

Lots that have common area fences on their property will receive a notice on their doors prior to our maintenance staff staining these fences. At that time, please move all items away from the fence so they are not damaged during spraying. Woodland Village will not be responsible for any damaged property.
