Association Trees

If you received a new Association tree this year, please note:

You will need to hand water your tree at least 5 to 10 gallons per week, to help get it through until next Spring.

Also, during the winter months your landscaping still needs attention. Most trees, shrubs, evergreens, and bulbs need watering once a month, unless we have unusually heavy snow on the ground.

Compliance Corner

If your backyard is up against common area, please do not throw trash, lawn clippings, pet waste or any other items over your back fence. This is a violation of the CC&R's and will result in fines.

If this is determined to be a health, safety, and welfare issue, you will be fined up to \$100 per week.

Also, this creates more work for the maintenance crew and could pose a health or fire hazard.

Design Committee!

If you are landscaping, re-landscaping or making changes to your home, you will need to submit plans to the Design Committee. Please make sure you have your design submitted at least 48 hours prior to the meeting. **No walk-ins will be accepted.** Design Committee will be starting their Winter hours and will be meeting only once a month.
