A note from Compliance:

As winter arrives, homeowners are responsible for snow and ice removal from sidewalks on their lots that are shared with the community.

Winter season recreational vehicles and their trailers are required to be stored behind a fence or garage out of common Area view.

Garbage Bins are also required to be stored out of sight but are permitted to be placed for pickup 24 hours before and after pickup day.

Road space is limited in snow and ice, to ensure utility and service vehicles have access to the community, driveway parking is greatly encouraged for homeowners and their guests. Vehicles not utilized daily are required to be stored in the garage or behind the fence.

Holiday decorations are to be taken down by January 31st, to avoid any compliance notices.
